ENROLLMENT EXPECTATIONS—2017-2018 Program

1. ATTENDANCE

- 1.1. I understand that this is a year-round program that is made up of a six-week summer program and a school year program with workshops and tutoring.
- 1.2. I understand that school year tutoring will be offered twice weekly for students who are below grade level in reading, and that participation is optional.
- 1.3. I understand that daily attendance is an important factor in each student's success.
- 1.4. I am committed to getting my child to the summer program on time every day except in the case of illness.
- 1.5. I agree that if my child misses 3 days during the first two weeks of the summer program or 5 days total, no matter what the reason, my child may be dismissed from the program.
- 1.6. I agree that if my child is tardy 3 days during the first two weeks of the summer program or 5 days total, no matter what the reason, my child may be dismissed from the program.
- 1.7. I understand that if my child does not complete the full summer program, my child will not be enrolled in the subsequent school year and summer programs.

2. SAFETY

- 2.1. For the safety of all students, ENHE has a sign-in and sign-out process.
- 2.2. I understand and agree that any person who brings my child to the program in the morning must escort my child into the building and sign-in.
- 2.3. I understand and agree that in order for a person to pick up my child, the person's name, including my own name, must be listed on the Enrollment Form.
- 2.4. I understand and agree that any person picking up my child, including myself, may be asked to prove their identity to the satisfaction of ENHE staff, most likely by showing their driver's license.
- 2.5. I agree that I will abide by the sign-in/sign-out process.

3. FAMILY PARTICIPATION

- 3.1. I understand that my involvement in my child's education and in this program is extremely important to my child's progress.
- 3.2. I will work with my child on reading materials each day for at least 10 minutes.
- 3.3. I will tell my child that I am proud of him/her at least one time each day.
- 3.4. I will remind my child about the importance of reading.
- 3.5. I understand that there will be weekly family engagement events during the summer.
- 3.6. I understand that there will be monthly workshops September-May during the school year for family members and students.
- 3.7. I understand that attendance at family participation events is mandatory.

4. BEHAVIOR

- 4.1. I understand that behavior-related disruptions can harm the learning environment for all students.
- 4.2. I understand that when a student exhibits behavior problems, ENHE staff will work with the student to try to help the student improve his or her behavior and will communicate with parents/caregivers when issues are more serious than what are considered "typical" behaviors.
- 4.3. I agree that if my child exhibits continued, disruptive behavior, my child may be dismissed from the program at the sole discretion of ENHE.
